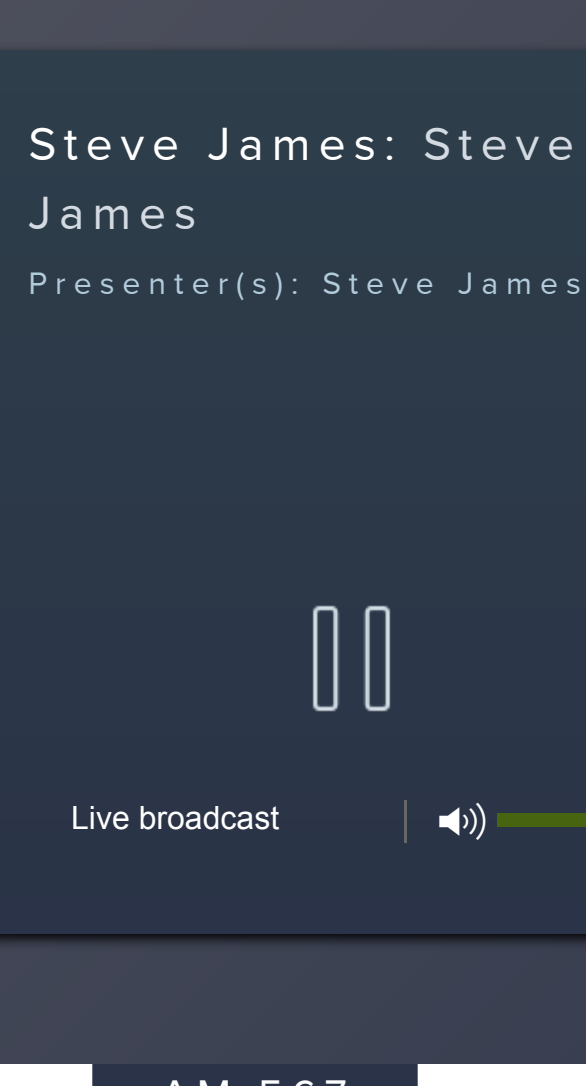
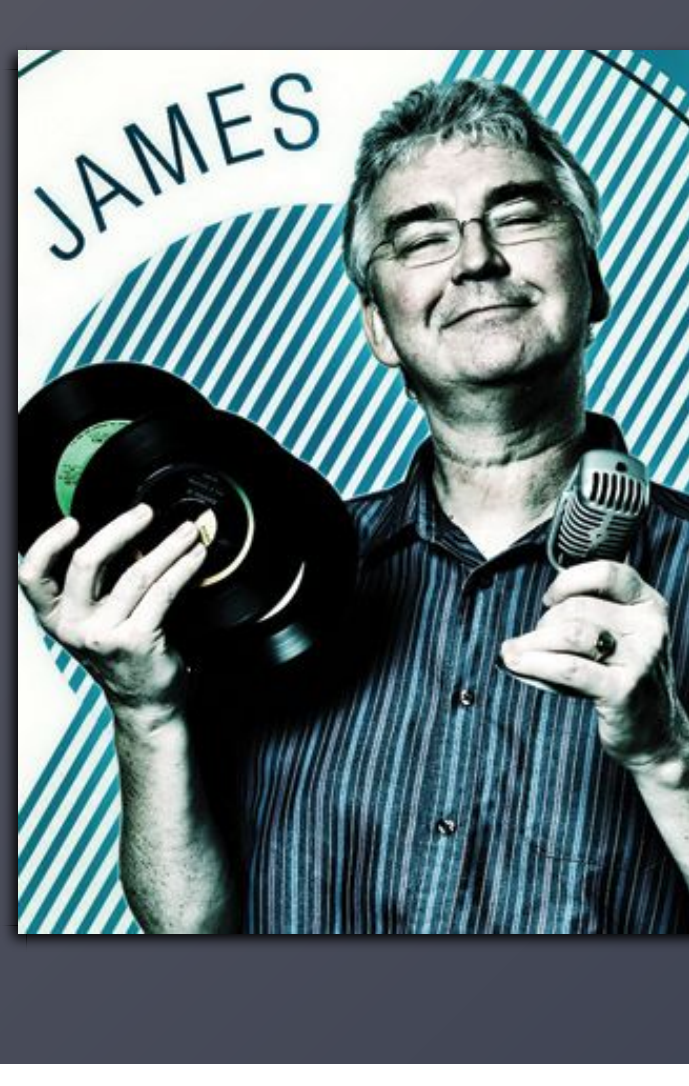

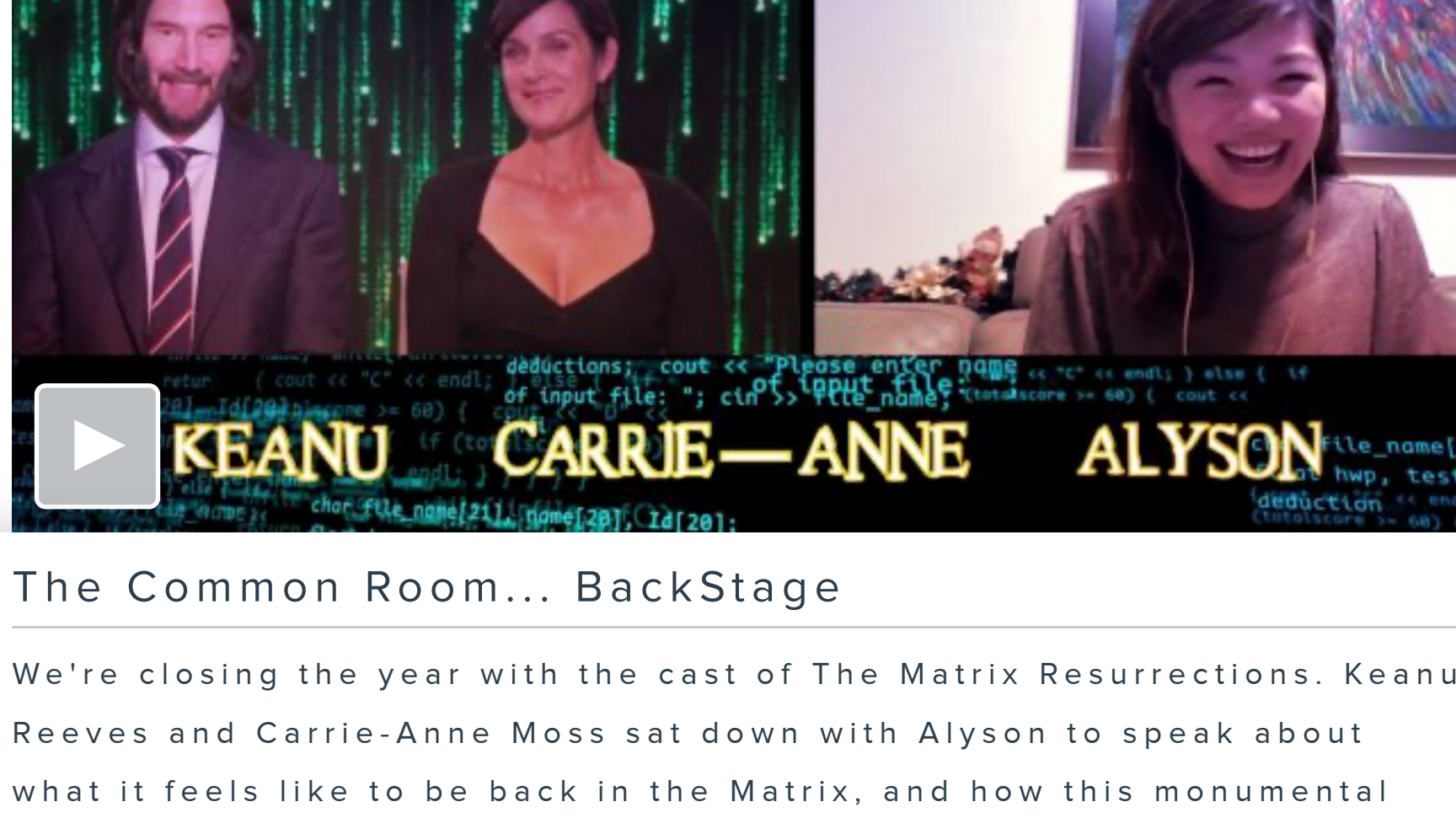

On Thursday's Backchat: Non-Fungible Tokens, and what to do with your Christmas tree?

NFT, or Non-Fungible Token, is the latest trading technology that has exploded in popularity in 2021. It basically transforms digital works of art and other collectibles into one-of-a-kind, verifiable assets that are easy to trade on the blockchain.

According to data from analytics platform DappRadar, the NFT Market has generated over US\$23 billion in trading volume in 2021, a huge jump from less than US\$100 million recorded last year.

But are NFTs worth the hype? Are they here to stay? And will they change investing forever?

Operation Santa Claus 2021

Operation Santa Claus (OSC), the annual charity campaign co-organised by the South China Morning Post and RTHK, is in full Christmas swing.

Some of our regular supporters have been having fun fundraising in all kinds of ways over the past few weeks. Morgan Stanley baked tempting pastries with the children from 2021 OSC's beneficiaries Integrated Brilliant Education, SLCO Community Resources, and The Zubin Foundation - and auctioned the cakes, with the highest bid of HK\$530,000! The leading investment bank also hosted a charity singing contest in December, and all these initiatives helped raise up to HK\$5.3 million, hitting a record high.

A big thanks to UBS, raising HK\$1.6 million for OSC through their charity Christmas party and auction; the Hong Kong Golf Club, who will donate 1 million HKD to the Home of Loving Faithfulness through OSC, and thanks to the players of the Wing Ding Charity Squash Tournament for raising HK\$398,110.

The Chinese Recreation Club, Hong Kong raised nearly HK\$40,000 for OSC and another local charity by organising the well-known Tennis Open, while one of our long lasting partners, Dah Sing Bank organised an adrenaline-rush basketball game amassing a total of HK\$200,000 for OSC's charity partners.

The Swire Properties White Christmas Street Fair held by Swire Properties from 2 - 5 December was a smashing success for its delicacies, upcycling Christmas décor, and live performances. Chinachem Group partnered for the first time with OSC in supporting the elderly, the disabled, teens, and many others in Kwai Tsing and Tsuen Wan areas. Besides sponsoring a series of "Performing Arts" (this year's theme) workshops for OSC's beneficiaries since early November, the Group has been paying regular home visits to residents in need, and donating laptops to students from underprivileged local families to facilitate online learning.
