Morning Brew

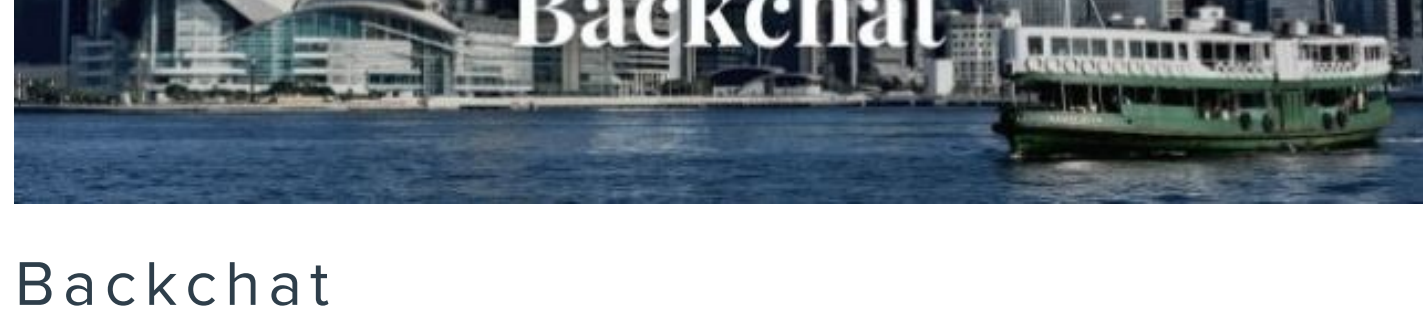

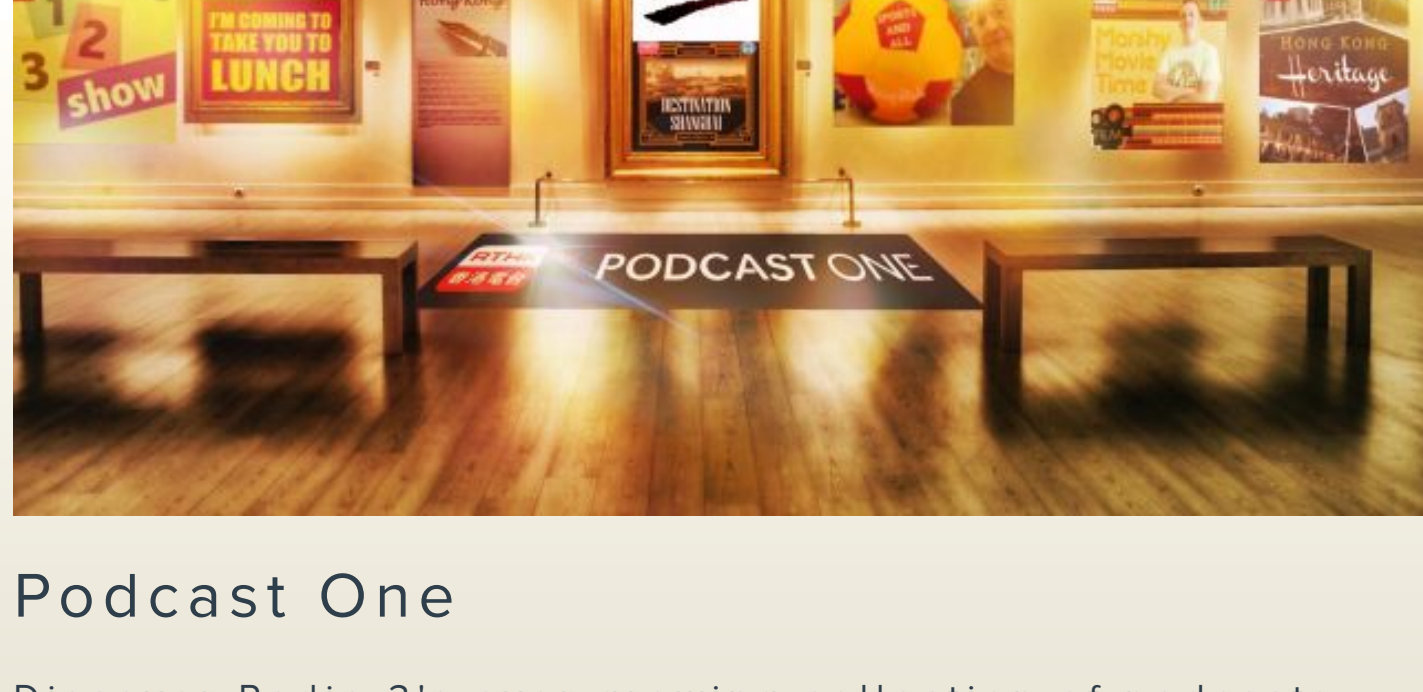
Sunset Sounds with Simon Willson

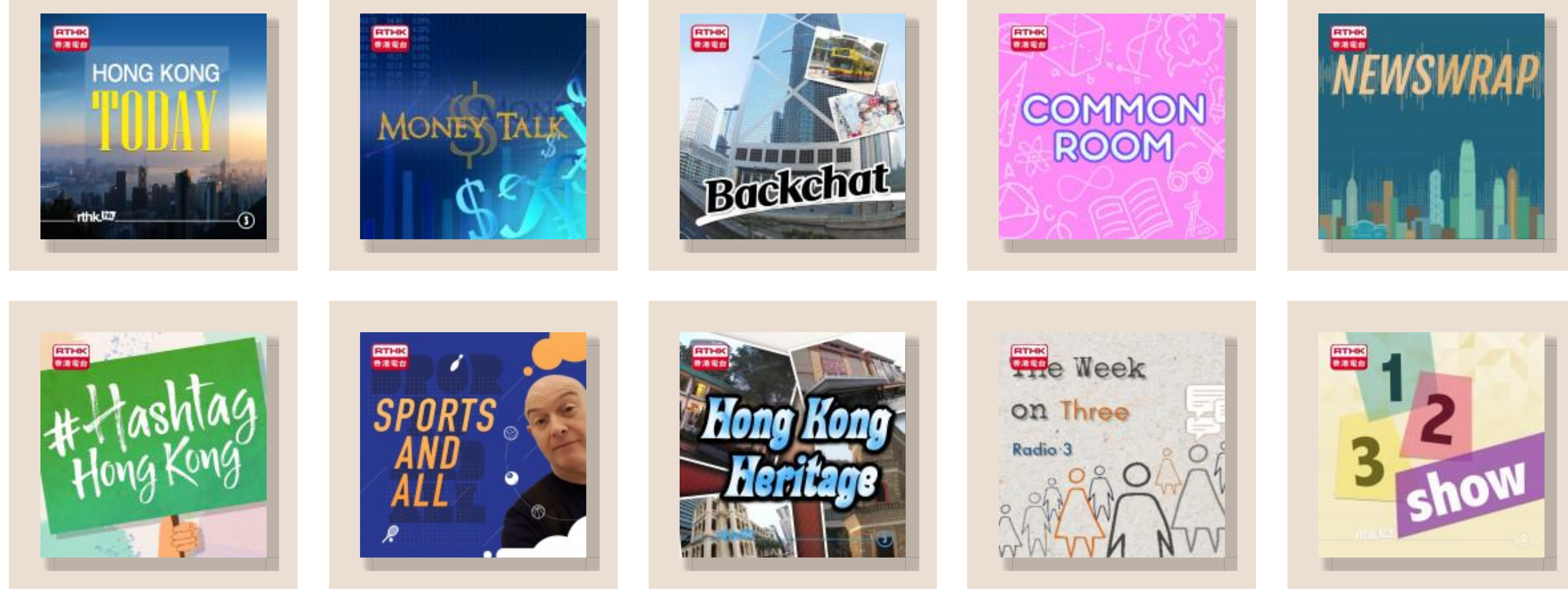

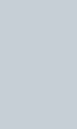

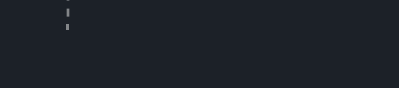
